

RESTRICTED MEDICATIONS

Any surgery carries a risk of bleeding or infection in the post-operative period. The risk of bleeding can be reduced by not consuming medications, vitamins and supplements that can affect your blood clotting capability. Please stop using any medication on the restricted list below for at least fourteen (14) days PRIOR TO any surgery and at least 4-5 days AFTER surgery. Although this is not a guarantee, avoidance of the medications can significantly reduce chances of bleeding from and following surgery. Tylenol is permissible during this period.
